



ANNEXURE A

Restrictions, Conditions or Stipulations in terms of Section 3(1) (b) of Regulation 638-Regulations Governing General Hygiene Requirements for Food Premises, the Transport of Food and Related Matters, framed in terms of the Foodstuffs, Cosmetics and Disinfectants Act, 1972 (Act No. 54 of 1972)

1. Full compliance with regulation R 638, Regulations Governing General Hygiene Requirements for Food Premises and the Transport of Food and Related Matters framed under the Foodstuffs, Cosmetics and Disinfectants Act, 1972 (Act 54 of 1972);
2. All pre-packed foodstuffs shall be suitably labelled in accordance with Regulation R146, Regulations relating to the labelling and advertising of foodstuffs, of the Foodstuffs, Cosmetics and Disinfectants Act,(Act 54 of 1972) ;
3. All foodstuffs for distribution to be transported in enclosed vehicles and all practical measures must be taken to prevent contamination.
4. Restricted against the smoking of tobacco products as a designated smoking area, in terms of the Tobacco Products Control Act has not been provided; and
5. Management must undertake to remedy any noise/odour or other nuisance that may arise from the premises.



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
